There are 5 "ranks" on our team: Team Member, Basic, Intermediate, Advanced, & Away Team. You can reach any level and stay there without any Pressure to get to the 5<sup>th</sup> level. Our Emergency Managers in the area will tell our ARES Team Leads what type of emergency / what is needed from ARES, and then our ARES Leadership can use this record of training to "callout" ARES members. A more technical response may be limited to Higher ranks only. But most of our callouts will be open to anyone that is at least a Team Member. (team member covers the most Basic Training Needed to be on our ARES Team) ALL of the training points inside of this book are FREE to you. You might also like CERT: North IA Community Emergency Response Team training teaches you readiness & response skills. Hands-on practice and realistic exercises prepare you for the unexpected in your community. Newly taught leadership skills empower you to safely respond to an emergency and assist victims without endangering yourself or others. You'll be equipped with skills that last a lifetime.
